Lakehead Amateur Radio Club

Meeting was called because of building which had become available suitable for Club House. This building, approximately 15' x 18', temporarily located on Dublin Avenue, Port Arthur, of log construction, for sale by Dr. Baker for \$300.00.

Hec Wilson - VE3DMZ outlined arrangements which could be made to have building moved to proposed new site. There was discussion on the advisability of the Club going into dept in order to make the purchase...Club funds amounting to approximately \$160.00. Hec Wilson - VE3DMZ volunteered to take financial responsibility for payment pending further accumulation of funds by the Club. Ballots were then distributed to take a vote on the purchase. This resulted in a 12 to 1 victory for the affirmative. A building committee will be organized under Hec Wilson - VE3DMZ.

Bob Adams - VE3ASL reported that we could use the Port Arthur Ski Club for Field Day. Details to be finalized at the regular June meeting on the 18th. Hec Wilson - VE3DMZ thought it should be possible to hold the Field Day in our own Club House. Bert Tamblin - VE3ANP proposed we write all amateurs in the District inviting them to visit the Club House when established. Increased membership might result which would assist Club funds to finance the Club House.

It was suggested that an increase be made in the annual membership dues. Proposed by Hec Wilson - VE3DMZ, seconded by Steve Bush - VE3EBS, that dues be made 50¢ per month or \$5.00 cash per year. This was carried.
