An Amateur Call Book was donated to the Club by J. C. (Jim) Bailey - VE3DGZ. The Club having no station on the air, it was loaned to VE3ECT (College Station).

The meeting adjourned on motion of Herman Dalman - VE3DJD, seconded by Choppy Walsh - VE3BPZ. The members were then entertained by a talk on various DOT stations, illustrated with coloured slides by Les Harris - VE3AYZ.

The meeting was then concluded with Coffee and doughnuts.
