

Minutes of the Meeting June 10, 1971

The monthly meeting of the Lakehead Amateur Radio Club was held on June 10 commencing at 8:15 in the EMO building.

A roll call showed 11 members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted on a motion by Vic Bel - VE3ECV and seconded by John Devavanyi - VE3GOW. Carried.

The financial report of the Treasury showed a bank balance of \$111.80 as of May 31.

A short publicity report was made by Ray Forslund - VE3EDZ.

A letter from the CNIB was read that requested support for a special edition of the Ontario Amateur that would appear in September. This edition would be entirely CNIB in content and all clubs were requested to consider placing advertisements about their groups in this special copy. On a motion by Jim Wheeler, Jim Wheeler - VE3EEG and seconded by Frank Start - VE3AJ it was decided to send \$10 to the RSO for this purpose.

A letter from the EMO was received that wanted to know if our Club required use of the EMO building during the summer months. It was unanimously felt that we did and Mr. Fallen would be so notified.

A brochure from the Bermuda Department of Trade and Tourism was shown that featured the Bermuda phone and CW contest with first prize being a trip to Bermuda.

Motion by Jim Wheeler - VE3EEG:- that the Club consider any photos on an individual basis and the reproductions (either black and white or colour) be paid for by the club, if not volunteered for the Club Photo album. Seconded by Vic Bel - VE3ECV and carried.

Motion by Vic Bel - VE3ECV:- That Ray Forslund - VE3EDZ be empowered to consider albums during the summer and submit a report in September on costs etc. Seconded by John Devavanyi -

VE3GOW and carried.

The last item of business was the election of a Field Day Chairman and the setting up of the Field Day Ray Forslund - VE3EDZ was voted to the position.
