

GENERAL MEETING

Jim Gain made a motion that Fred Prins be asked to undertake the Co-editorship of High-Q. Seconded by Phil Moorey and Carried.

The Search and Rescue Unit call-up was discussed and liaison, Bill Klemacki - VE3EEW, asked if there were any more people that would like to be placed on the list that were not already on it. Following a short break, VE3AYZ showed slides on his recent trip to Europe.
