Added a point D to the Legal part of Ed's submission Saying:  
At a time that the trailer becomes cost ineffective to the LARC it will be sold. Any money resulting from this sale will be put into a project that benefits the community

Also edited the Financing section to reflect what the executive decided Financing

The volunteer committee may, with the consent of the director or the Board, solicit donations of monies or material for use for the trailer. All monies must be surrendered to the club treasurer, or designated person, who will place the monies in an account earmarked for use by the committee. All expenditures will follow present club procedures. All material donated must be itemized and attached to the file. The earmarked funds must be exhausted before the membership will consider funding from general revenues.
