

General Meeting

September 9, 1976

The first meeting of the autumn season was called to order by President Pat Doherty - VE3HFS at 8:10pm.

Bill Klemacki - VE3EEW was to teach theory if Pat Doherty - VE3HFS teaches code. They hope to commence on September 22, 1976. Bill Boland - VE3BQR made a motion seconded by Bill Klemacki - VE3EEW, to boost full membership to \$10.00. Motion carried.

Second motion by Bill Boland - VE3BQR was to raise Associate membership to \$3.00 and Family membership to \$12.00. (The) \$5.00 paid for classes would also include Associate Membership. Tom Haavisto - VE3HHS was the seconder. The multiple motion was carried.
