Welcome to the world of Packet Radio, at the next LARC meeting, we are going to explore Packet Radio. In particular, we are going to check out VE3NPS, Nestor's Node. He has a setup that allows you to go in on 2 metres and output on 20 metres to "Network 105." If we can't use that we will try connecting across the Lake into the Upper Peninsula or even into VA3SAM, in Gull Bay, who knows!

I've included the help files for both Nestor's and VE3TBR systems so you can follow along with us as we give the demonstration.

Also, we will show you how simple it is to get on packet, you don't need to be an electronics wizard or computer geek.
