

MOTION:

THAT THE MEMBERSHIP PERSUE THE EXPANSION OF THE VE3YQT REPEATER SITE BY:

- i) Purchasing a GE MASTER II repeater, complete with morse ID, battery back up, 3 minute time out timer, and subtone compatable with the tone operated squelch on our present UHF link and autopatch.
- ii) Upgrading our antenna to a SINCLAIR SRL21ØC4.
- iii) Upgrading our duplexers to a SINCLAIR 6 CAVITY RES-LOK Q-233ØE.
- iv) Employing a proffesional rigger to remove our present, and install our new antenna at the Mount Baldy site.
- v) Changing our present VE3YQT input frequency to 147.660 in an effort to keep in line with the standardized VHF band plan.
- vi) Moving our present VE3YQT repeater and antenna to the EAST SITE. (with the EAST SITE being determined at a later date)
- vii) Persuing the installation, linking and control of the EAST SITE, utilizing club members, as selected here tonight by memebers present at this meeting, and including our VE3YQT maintenance person Laurie Bridgett, VE3BCD.
- viii) Ensuring that the 1988-1989 EXECUTIVE follow through with this motion as read here tonight, this Thursday 12 May 1988.
